Techniques and Tips. Write phrases, not full sentences. Only record the key words that you need to get the idea of the point. Skip words like “the” and “a” that don’t add additional meaning to the lecture content.

Note Taking Area: Record lecture as fully and as meaningfully as possible. Cue Column: As you're taking notes, keep cue column empty. Soon after

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the lecture, reduce your notes to concise jottings as clues for Reciting, Reviewing, and Reflecting. Summaries: Sum up each page of your notes in a sentence or two. This format provides the perfect opportunity for following through with the 5 R's of ...
