There are two kinds of tests that are used to determine if a person has been infected with TB bacteria: the TB blood test and the TB skin test. TB blood tests (sometimes called IGRAs) use a blood sample to find TB infection. The tests measure the response of TB proteins when they are mixed with a small amount of blood.

A TB skin test is also called a Mantoux tuberculin skin test (TST). The test is usually well-tolerated, and people rarely have negative reactions to it. A TB skin test is done in two parts:

What Does a Positive TB Skin Test Look Like?

A TB skin test measures the body's immune response to antigens derived from these bacteria. TB may cause an inactive (latent) infection or an active, progressive disease. The immune system of about 90% of people who become infected with TB manages to control its growth and confine the TB infection to a few cells in the body.

The tuberculosis skin test is another name for the tuberculin test or PPD test.; The PPD test determines if someone has developed an immune response to the bacterium that causes tuberculosis (.); Blood tests for TB are also available, and health care professionals may use them in place of the PPD skin test. This measurement is different for children, people with HIV, and other high-risk groups. The PPD skin test is not a perfect screening test. TB skin test For the TB skin test, a liquid called tuberculin is injected into the skin of the forearm. Within two or three days, a health care professional checks the injection site for a bump or raised area that can indicate infection with the TB bacteria.

A person who tests positive for tuberculosis (TB) has likely been exposed (at some point in their lives) to either Mycobacterium tuberculosis (the organism that causes infectious TB) or protein from the bacterium. So yes, once exposed, a person will always have a positive test that reflects the history of that exposure.

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
